RISE<sup>™</sup> is a collaboration of individuals and organizations who wish to cast a wide net to awaken today's man. Our goal is simple: to use powerful media as a tool to present the true path to freedom and peace by challenging men to live the fullness of their vocation every day; at home, at work, and in their communities. We are creating a tool that those in ministry can use to draw men in, while at the same time strengthening and inspiring their current members.

RISE gives men a battle plan for daily living, while walking alongside them each day. When men understand their profound dignity as sons of God, and are re-oriented towards what really matters, the impact on themselves and those around them will be significant.
